

## **ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON MINORITY FARMERS**

The Advisory Committee on Minority Farmers (ACMF) has 15 members who will serve as representatives in the following areas: Six (6) or more members shall be or shall work closely with minority farmers or ranchers; two (2) or more members will be from institutions of higher education who work with minority farming communities; two (2) or more individuals will represent and bring feedback from community-based nonprofit organizations; and two (2) or more members will be or will have worked closely with civil rights professionals or organizations that track minority farming equity issues. As the ACMF members will represent historically underserved farming communities and the individuals who support them, its membership should reflect the diversity in geography, ethnicity, gender, race, and as to production - size, scale, type of product or service, etc.
